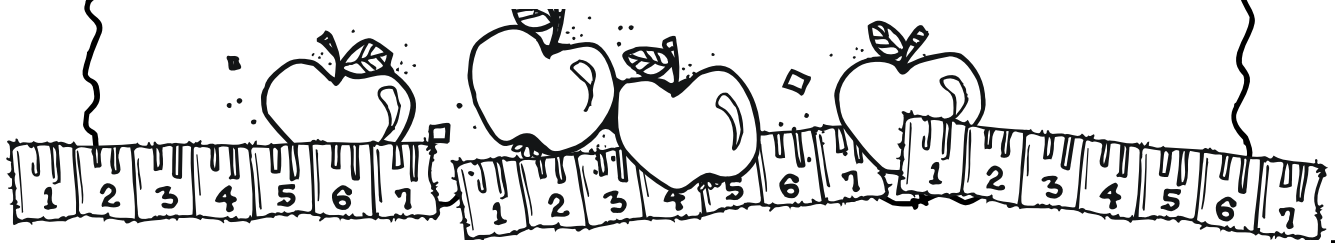


Kindergarten Korner
