Reading Goals:

It is important that you sit down to read with your child every day! When your child is reading he/she should be able to look at the pictures for clues and look at letters in words for clues to read the words. If it seems like their reading is memorized, try covering up the pictures and force them to just look at the words. When you are reading to your child, stop throughout the book and have them predict what will happen next. When the story is complete, ask them what their favorite part was or ask them to retell the story. It is important for them to retell it in sequential order. The questioning step is often forgotten about but it is of great importance!
