2	Annually, students/parents will review and acknowledge the Acceptable Use Policy during the registration process.				
3	The district will adopt the National Education Standards (Department of Education) as technology competencies.				
4	Curriculum and Instruction will work to embed technology standards in each content area district curriculum, aligned vertically and horizontally.				
5	Students will demonstrate competencies in the use of technology through district aligned technology benchmarks (Department of Education, National Educational Technology Standards for Students) administered annually to each student.				
6	Technology will be used by all students from K-12 to facilitate learning.				
7	Create virtual GCISD classrooms via podcasts, video lectures and other digital learning experiences, to make content continuously available to staff, students and parents.				
8	Campus Instructional Technologists will act as co-facilitators in classes to assist in technology integration.				
9	GCISD will survey students to determine interest and motivation for learning through technology applications.				
10	All teachers will begin each instructional unit by telling students the expected learning outcomes and soliciting student input for utilizing technology in the learning process.
